



SHELL SIGNS AGREEMENT TO DEVELOP LNG TERMINAL AND SUPPLY LNG TO MYANMAR

Shell has signed a Joint Development Agreement (JDA) with Italian-Thai Development Public Company limited (ITD) and LNG Plus International company limited (LNGP) to cooperate on the development of a proposed Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) receiving and re-gasification terminal in the Dawei Special Economic Zone (DSEZ) in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar.

Roger Bounds, Vice President Global LNG at Shell said: “We are very pleased with this agreement. We believe that this opportunity will enable Shell, together with its partners, to bring its global expertise in LNG to Myanmar to help meet the country’s energy aspirations.”
