Areas of Operation Merit Award, East (OE) The Shell Nigeria Areas of Operation Merit Award, East (OE) University Scholarship is open to first year full-time degree students in Nigerian universities who are indigenes of Shell's operational areas in Abia, Akwa Ibom, Imo Rivers and Bayelsa States (excluding indigenes of Ekeremor and Sagbama Local Government Areas). Apply in writing using the format below only and send in an envelope clearly marked 2006/2007 OE Award to:

2b. Areas of Operation Merit Award, West (OW) - who can apply?

The Shell Nigeria Areas of Operation Merit Award, West (OW) University Scholarship is open to first year full-time degree students in Nigerian universities who are indigenes of Shell's operational areas in Bayelsa (i.e indigenes of Ekeremor and Sagbama Local Government Areas), Delta and Edo States. Apply in writing using the format below only and send in an envelope clearly marked 2006/2007 OW Award to:

2. Photocopy of University Matriculation Examinations (UME) Scores;
3. Photocopy of SSCE / GCE O/ Level Result; of A/ Level, and / or OND Result;
4. Two recent passport-sized photographs of the applicant should be stapled to the top right hand corner of application (with Name, School & Course written on the back); and
5. Letter of Identification from State (showing Local Government) of Origin;

For applicants for the Operational Area Award, Letters of Identification duly stamped and signed by:

- (1) The Paramount Ruler of the Community; and
- (2) The Chairman of the Community Executive Council (CEC) **or** The Chairman of the Community Development Council (CDC).

Please note that:

- **Shell does not demand payment from applicants; the application is entirely FREE of charge.**
- **Prospective applicants must be Nigerians, who are registered as full-time degree students in a Nigerian University only. (The scheme does not cover other degree-awarding institutions).**
