### EXTENDING EQUIPMENT LIFE IS A PRIORITY, AND COMPANIES KNOW EFFECTIVE MAINTENANCE IS KEY

## CHALLENGES TO OPTIMAL IMPLEMENTATION

### MAINTENANCE TEAMS UNDER STRAIN

**1 in 3**

think they have too few maintenance staff



**61%**

say their team is always under pressure to cut costs



### ABSENCE OF SENIOR MANAGEMENT SUPPORT

**49%**

think equipment maintenance is not sufficiently valued by senior management



### KNOWLEDGE GAP ON EFFECTIVE LUBRICATION

**60%**

don't realise effective lubrication can help reduce equipment downtime



**58%**

don't expect it can help lower maintenance costs

### MORE TRAINING IS REQUIRED

**77%**

think their maintenance staff would benefit from additional lubrication training

### LUBRICATION ERRORS ARE LEADING TO AVOIDABLE COSTS AND DELAYS

often experience breakdowns due to ineffective lubrication



### COLLABORATION IS CRITICAL TO HELP COMPANIES PREPARE TO SUCCEED

#### THIRD-PARTY ADVICE IS IN DEMAND

think external maintenance support is currently insufficient



#### LUBRICANTS EXPERTISE WOULD ADD VALUE

**76%**

believe a lubricant supplier who can share expertise would be valuable to their company
