



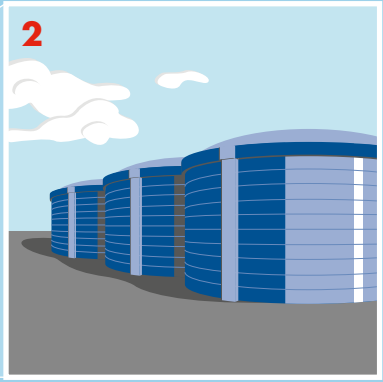
SHELL LNG FOR TRANSPORT

AT THE GAS ACCESS TO EUROPE (GATE) TERMINAL*

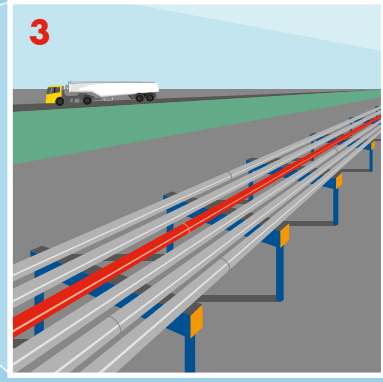
Shell is bringing liquefied natural gas (LNG) fuel one step closer to its marine and heavy-duty on-road customers in northwestern Europe via the Gasunie/Vopak Gate terminal.



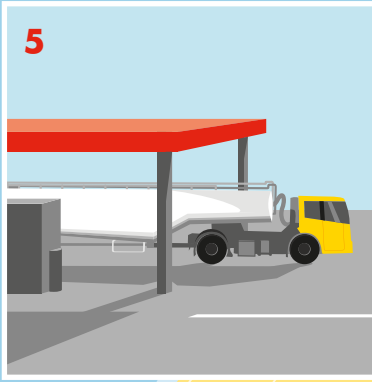
Shell LNG arrives at the Gate Terminal on carriers from around the world



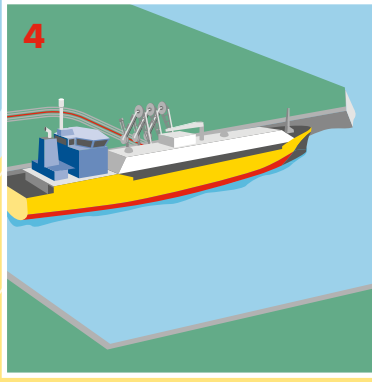
LNG will be offloaded and stored in LNG tanks on site



LNG will be transported by pipeline to the new break bulk terminal and existing LNG truck loading facilities



LNG will be loaded onto trucks and delivered to road customers. Shell will also provide LNG to an initial network of LNG refuelling truck stops at several locations in the Netherlands



Shell intends to charter a specialised LNG bunker vessel to serve marine customers
